

Camping and Night Diving at Dutch Springs

IMPORTANT TIMES:

5:00 PM – All tanks must be up to the air fill station to be filled by this time
Everyone camping or night diving must be up at the front office by this time to register and have a wristband placed on their wrist.

All divers must be under the water by this time for their last dive

All non-divers must be out of the water by this time

- The Aqua Park is closed at this time and will reopen the next day at 10 am
- No swimming, snorkeling, kayaking, or wading in the water
- Please keep away from the water's edge

5:45 PM – All divers must be out of the water by this time

- No reentry into the water for diving until night dive (Saturday night only)

6:00 PM – Anyone who is not camping or night diving must be out of our gates by this time.

_____ **PM (½ Hour Before Sunset)** – Night Dive Begins – Divers can start entering the water for the night dive

_____ **PM (1/2 Hour After Sunset)** – All Night Divers must be under the water by this time

8:30 PM – *All campers must be on the property by this time.*

_____ **PM (2 Hours After Sunset) or 10:00 PM which ever time is earlier** – Everyone not camping must be out of the gates by this time

- The gates are closed and locked at this time. No one is allowed in or out of the gate until 7:15 when staff arrives the next morning. At 7:15 am you would be allowed to leave for breakfast (please ask for a car pass) but re-entry would be at 8:00 am when we open for the day.
- **If there is an emergency**, go to the clipboard hanging by the entrance gate. The clipboard will list the person who has the key to the gate. Re-entry would be at 8:00 am when we open for the day.
- Parking outside the gate and jumping over the fence to gain access to Dutch Springs after we are closed is not allowed.

WRISTBANDS:

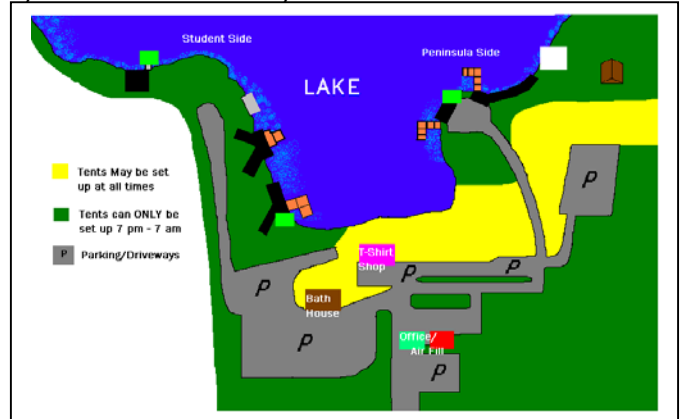
- By 5:00 pm everyone – from instructor to child - that is on the property after 6:00 pm must register at the front office and have a wristband placed on their wrist
- Dutch Springs' admissions staff will attach the wristband in the front office. Sorry, you cannot sign a friend up and take the wristband with you.
- Campers must keep their wristband on until 8:00 am the next morning
- Night Divers must keep their wristband on until leaving for the night.
- If the wristband comes off, go to the front office with the torn wristband for a replacement.

NIGHT DIVE: Saturday night only! You must be under the supervision of an instructor or advanced certified!

Fees: Divers: \$5.00 – Please bring Advanced or Above C-Card when registering for the night dive
Season Pass Holders, Instructors, Divers Assisting a Class, Non-Divers and Children: Free

Rules:

1. By 5:00 pm everyone – from instructor to child - that is on the property after 6:00 pm must register at the front office and have a wristband placed on their wrist
2. All night divers must have a light stick (sold at the t-shirt shop) or strobe light in addition to the dive light.
3. Everyone must be in the water within a half hour after sunset and out of the water and off the property (if not camping) within two hours after sunset or by 10:00 pm, whichever is earlier. No one is allowed in the water after this time.
4. Dutch Springs staff is watching the lake during night dive.
5. After the night dive is completed there is no entry in the water for any reason.



CAMPING: Friday and Saturday nights only!

Fees: 10 yrs and older: \$10.00/person/night
5 – 9 yrs: \$5.00/person/night
Instructors and Children under 5 yrs: Free
Admission for the next day must be purchased when paying for camping.

Rules:

1. By 5:00 pm everyone – from instructor to child - that is on the property after 6:00 pm must register at the front office and have a wristband placed on their wrist.
2. After 5:00 p.m. there is no entry (including Aqua Park, snorkeling, boating, swimming or wading) to the water.
3. Tents can not be set up in the student area or on the peninsula (where the picnic tables are) until after 6:00 p.m. and must be taken down by 7:30 a.m. Sunday morning. On all other grass areas, tents may be set up and remain up all weekend.
4. RV's must remain in the parking lots. Only RV's owned by instructors can be parked on the peninsula.
5. All fires must be in grills (no open fires on the ground). Grills can not be set directly on picnic tables or the grass so they burn the wood or the grass.
6. The change building will remain open all night.
7. All campers must be on the property by 8:30 pm. This time will change when the sun sets earlier. On Saturday night once the night dive is completed the gate will be locked. A Dutch Springs staff member who is staying on the property overnight will have a key to be used only in an emergency.
8. Parking outside the gate and jumping over the fence to gain access to Dutch Springs after we are closed is not allowed. Signs have placed on the fence outside the gate stating that if someone jumps the fence, they will be asked to leave the property. This pertains to anyone from a non-diver to an instructor.
9. Quiet time starts at 11:00 p.m.
10. If camping overnight, but leaving the next morning, the entrance fee for the next day must be paid. As long as everyone is out of the gates by 9 am. The days entrance fee will be refunded.
11. Campers may leave the property to go out for breakfast Sunday morning at 7:15 am. At that time, campers can leave but can not get back inside the gates until Dutch Springs opens for the day at 8 am. Please stop at the front office to get a car pass before leaving the grounds.
